

Refund Policy for Basketball Club Rhode Island (BCRI)

Basketball Club Rhode Island (BCRI) operates as an AAU program that provides basketball teams during two separate seasons each year: the Fall AAU season and the Spring AAU season. Each season is treated as its own entity, and payments for one season do not carry over to the next. Participation in BCRI programs requires the payment of specific fees, each governed by the following policies:

1. Tryout Fee

- A \$20 tryout fee is required to participate in tryouts.
- This fee is NON-REFUNDABLE under any circumstances.

2. Season Registration Fee

The season registration fee is outlined in a roster invitation email and consists of two parts:

Part 1: Non-Refundable Deposit

- A \$300 non-refundable deposit is required to secure a roster spot.
- This deposit must be made within 48 hours of the invitation email being sent. The email
 explicitly states: "In order to secure your spot, we are requiring a deposit of \$300.00 as
 we have a waiting list. Please note this deposit will be deducted from the full season cost
 listed below."
- If the deposit is not made within the 48-hour window, BCRI reserves the right to retract the invitation and offer the roster spot to an athlete on the waiting list.

Part 2: Remaining Balance

• The remaining balance of the season registration fee can be paid in full, later, or through a payment plan. BCRI will provide payment deadlines for each season.

Registration Fee Policy

- ALL REGISTRATION FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE.
- Once the registration form and payment are submitted, the athlete's roster spot is confirmed and secured. This policy is in place because team rosters are finalized, uniforms and facility costs are paid, and accepting the spot prevents another athlete from participating due to a waiting list.
- If payment deadlines are not met, BCRI will send reminder emails, text communications, and explore other avenues to retrieve full payment. If full payment is made late, BCRI reserves the right to add a late fee at our discretion. If attempts to retrieve full payment fail and there is no communication or attempts to pay made by parents, BCRI will remove the athlete from the team.

Team Placement Adjustments

- BCRI reserves the right to change team placement without prior written consent or approval from parents if the directors and team coaches believe the current team placement is no longer appropriate for the athlete.
- Adjustments may involve moving the athlete up or down a skill level to better fit their development goals when possible.
- If no appropriate team placement is available for the athlete, BCRI will issue a partial refund for the remainder of the current season.

Injuries

- Injuries are an unfortunate part of the game and are addressed on a case-by-case basis.
- BCRI reserves the right to issue a credit for the following season in which the athlete is healthy and eligible to participate.
